

Saturday/Sunday 19/20 March Welsh Weekend

Paxton's Tower, Carmarthenshire, Cilwendeg Shell House, Pembrokeshire and Foel Ortho Follies near Penybontfawr

Saturday will start with light refreshments and a visit to Paxton's Tower near Carmarthen then on to Cilwendeg in the afternoon. The Cilwendeg Shell House Hermitage is a most remarkable ornamental grotto, and a rare survival in West Wales. It was built in the late 1820s by Morgan Jones the Younger, who inherited the Cilwendeg estate upon the death of his uncle and created the Shell House in his uncle's honour. This extraordinary woodland retreat was conceived in the picturesque taste of the era, and in addition to serving as a grateful tribute to the elder Jones, it was used by his family as a cool amusement in the summer months and a contemplative reading room in the depths of the winter. When Headley and Meulenkamp saw it 'most of the decoration had disappeared' but recently it was bought by the Temple Trust, and restored in 2007 by architect Roger Clive-Powell and shell specialist Blott Kerr-Wilson. It is quite stunning and must be seen. Roger Clive-Powell will show us round.

We suggest staying in Aberystwyth on Saturday night and meeting up for a meal. On Sunday there will be a visit to Foel Ortho Follies near Penybontfawr.
